

**Ten Most Common Complaints to the NNBA Disciplinary Committee
and Corresponding Provisions of the Model Rules**

1. Accepting money from client and doing no work - Rule 1.3
2. Excessive fees - Rule 1.5
3. Failure to attend hearings - Rule 1.3
4. Failure to communicate with client - Rule 1.4
5. Ex Parte communications with a person represented by counsel
6. Professional incompetence
7. Violation of duties as a prosecutor
8. Client lost
9. Counsel for adverse party was successful
10. Rudeness
